It would be courteous if you receive a lift to make a small contribution to the driver for the use of transport and towards the fuel used, we would leave this to your discretion.

With Covid present we encourage you to take care if sharing transport, ventilate vehicles where possible, carry a face covering in case they are required entering buildings and vehicles.
