### **Message from Revd Dr David Perry, Chairman of Lincoln and Grimsby Methodist District**

I shall be running the Humber bridge half-marathon on Sunday 26th June to raise money for Cancer Research UK. Just before Easter my father-in-law Gerald had an unsuccessful operation for lung cancer and is now taking part in a clinical trial of combined chemotherapy and radiotherapy at Treliske hospital in Truro. Back in 1993 my mother-in-law died of cancer in the year that they were due to retire. Gerald is a supernumerary Methodist Minister, has been a hospital chaplain at Treliske and is a former General Secretary of what was then the Methodist Church's Division of Social Responsibility. As his son-in-law I want to support him and running the half-marathon to raise money for cancer research (my first since the mid 1980's although I regularly run 10k's) seems a very practical way of doing this. I shall be attending the Methodist Conference at Loughborough from 22nd June to 2nd July and hope to raise money there from the 300+ representatives, some of whom will remember Gerald personally.
