### **THE LINCOLN CITY 'D.E.C.' COLLECTIONS**

Churches together in Lincoln & District & Lincoln City Council are co-operating in a series of street collections for those who have suffered in the Indian Ocean Tsunami of 26th December. Peter Pillinger has been asked by the city council to co-ordinate this!! Money collected will go to the Disasters Emergency Committee Appeal. Money will be collected on Lincoln High Street and other shopping areas on three days spread over the next 6 months. The first collection was made yesterday. Other collections will be announced in the future. Each day will be split into the following collection periods: 9.30 – 11.00; 11.00 – 12.30; 12.30 – 2.00; 2.00 – 3.30; 3.30 – 5.00

I am looking for a minimum of ten people for each period to act as a collection team. With more authorised collectors we can reach more of the city. If a church would take on one or more of these periods that would make arrangements easier for me!! People need to be over 16 and to have the support of their minister or priest. (We need to ensure collectors are bona fide as there have already been cases of fraudulent collections.) It is important that all volunteers are authorised so you will not be able to arrive on the day. City Council employees can be authorised through the council.

I need to know names, addresses and ages of volunteers urgently so that authorisation badges can be prepared by the city council. If anyone is willing co-ordinate members from Burton Road or help Peter with some of the footwork please speak to one of the stewards. Thank you.
