Global Prayer: In recent days, Open Doors workers in Iraq have reported increased violence against Christians in the country as Ramadan and statements from the Pope have ignited an explosive atmosphere. Several Christians have been murdered, others have been abused and kidnapped, and churches have been fired upon and bombed. A hand grenade was thrown at a priest's car. In Baghdad and Mosul, several churches have been attacked. On 27 September, a group of men reportedly fired rockets on the Chaldean Church of the Holy Spirit in Mosul and detonated an explosive device outside the church door, and sadly these are just a few examples. Please PRAY for Angelic and providential protection of Christians in Iraq; the restraint of demonic powers that would stir up rage and Islamic extremism; strength for Iraqi believers and their children; wisdom for Church leaders in Iraq and safety and protection for Open Doors workers in the country.

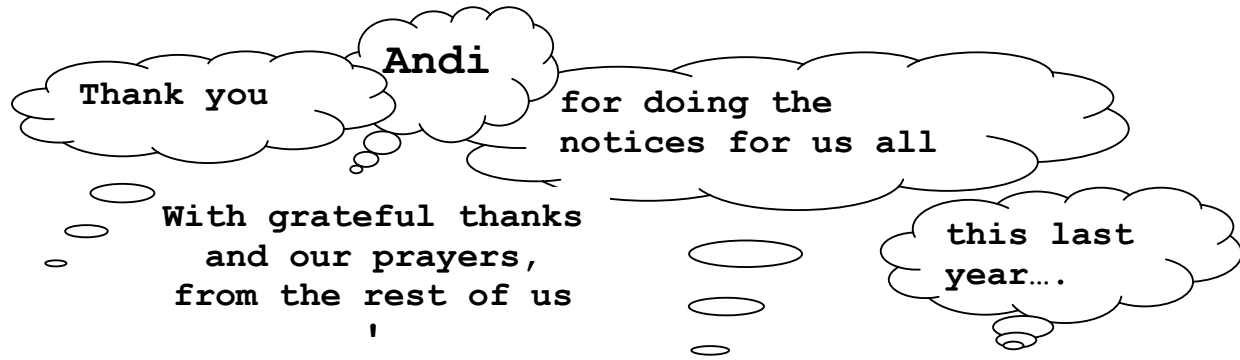
