News from Pakistan with Operation Mobilisation.....The biggest sports ministry event in the history of Pakistan was held this November 18 - 19 in Lahore. 456 children from 19 churches, plus 150 Sunday School teachers and volunteer helpers and 175 spectators gathered for KidsGames in a stadium decorated with Bible verses and banners. Some 40 blind and disabled children were special guests. The event was a joint effort of OM Pakistan, Pakistan Sunday School Ministry, Peace through Education and Sports, Sports Ambassadors of Pakistan and World Sports Ministry. Please remember the total of 110 children who gave their lives to the Lord.
