### Global Prayer:

OUT OF DISPAIR with OM in India....Panjavalli is a 50 year old woman who lost all her possessions and family members in the 2004 Asian tsunami. More than one year later she still lives in a refugee camp and has made no progress toward physical or emotional recovery. An OM India film team visited her coastal village recently to show a film about the life of Jesus. Hundreds of still suffering tsunami victims gathered to watch the film including Panjavalli, who later approached team members to share her story and ask questions. She explained that her emotional state was so bad that she had decided to commit suicide. The team comforted her, reminding her of what she had seen in the film. At the end of the meeting she expressed her desire to follow Jesus and shared that she felt an overwhelming sense of peace when the team prayed for her.
