Global Prayer: News from Liberia with help from The Bible Society....Recently the fully translated Bassa Bible was launched for the 350,000 people in Liberia who speak the language. The Bible was presented to a congregation of more than 500 people at the World Wide Church in Buchanan. The celebrations were a tribute to the many people who, over the decades and in the face of civil war and other restrictions, have devoted themselves to bringing God's word to Bassa speakers. THANK God that the civil war in Liberia seems to be coming to an end. PRAY that churches will show greater support for the Bible Society in Liberia. PRAY for the Spirits power to change the lives of the Bassa people who do not yet know God. PRAY for the completion and launch of the Gbloo New Testament for the 40,000 people in the SW area of Liberia who have never had any part of scripture in their own language before.
