Global Prayer:

With help from Tearfund we focus again on the troubled country of Indonesia. Last week we prayed for Earthquake stricken Java, where the suffering goes on, and your prayers are still much needed. This week we move to the fledgling former Indonesian country of East Timor which has seen much persecution of the Christian church. At this present time there is much unrest with protestors in Dill the capitol demanding the resignation of their prime minister. Due to fighting that has erupted at least 20 people have been killed, and a further 65,000 have fled their homes and are sheltering in makeshift campsites. The UN has airlifted in supplies such as tents, water containers and blankets, while international peacekeepers are trying to bring an end to the violence. Please PRAY that the peacekeepers will succeed in ending the violence, and that people will soon be able to return home. PRAY that the government of East Timor will rule the country with wisdom and honour.
