Prayer Points from Tearfund. Every minute a baby is born with HIV, somewhere in one of the poorest places in the world. But you can stop this happening. A few cheap, simple measures can prevent the spread of HIV from mother to child. PRAY for babies born with HIV: that they would know love and belonging as they grow up and that they would be supported by their communities. PRAY for women in poor countries who may not be aware that they are HIV positive, that the fear and ignorance surrounding HIV-testing would be broken down so that mothers can get access to treatment for themselves and protection for their babies.
