NEWS FROM 'THE BIBLE SOCIETY' IN GAZA CITY.....Rami Ayyad, manager of the Bible Society's bookshop in Gaza City, has been abducted and murdered. Now supporters are being urged to pray urgently for his family and colleagues. Mr Ayyad was kidnapped near his home in Gaza City on Saturday. His body was found on Sunday morning elsewhere in the city. He leaves a widow, Pauline and two children. Bible Society staff in Palestine are also in shock at his death. Rami was the most gentle member of the team, the ever smiling one. Please pray for his family, the team and all Christ-followers in Gaza as they struggle with the grief of the loss of a colleague, friend, husband and father. We know that he was martyred for his faith in Christ.
