TEARFUND REPORTS ON FLOODING DISASTER IN INDIA: More than 2 million people have been severely affected by floods in the Indian state of Bihar. The area's chief minister has described the deluge, caused by the river Koshi in neighbouring Nepal bursting its banks, as a 'catastrophe'. Tearfund is working with several long term partners in the area to bring relief to those who are suffering. Please pray that families affected by the flooding will survive this ordeal with assistance from government and voluntary organisations. Pray that partners will have wisdom and strength to conduct relief in target areas. Pray for funds to support emergency operations being proposed, as the church steps in to support Tearfund and our partners in providing vital help.
