ZIMBABWE HOLDS ITS BREATH AFTER ELECTIONS: Many observers believe there is likely to be a run-off between President Mugabe and the opposition leader Morgan Tsvangirai. If there's a run-off, it'll mean another three weeks of tension because people won't know what's happening and there's increased potential for intimidation and violence. Tearfunds partner, the Zimbabwe Christian Alliance, deployed staff to monitor the elections and to gather any information about voting irregularities. It is tiring and potentially risky work and they need your prayers for strength and protection. Pray for continued calm despite the heightened atmosphere in Zimbabwe. Pray too for peaceful change according to God's will and timing.
