Now back in the predominantly Muslim country, he leads the interconfessional Bible Society of Albania. Since it was formed 11 years ago, the IBSA has focused on translating the Bible. Praise God for the completion of the translation of the interconfessional New Testament, its publication, and the production of an audio version. Pray for the collaboration that exists between the various denominations, that there is a continued unity among Christians.
