Tearfund does not have partners in Sichuan province, but we pray for those affected by the earthquake which registered 7.8 on the Richter Scale. Please pray for the survivors of the earthquake, that the injured receive medical help quickly and the homeless receive relief supplies. Pray that the Chinese authorities respond effectively in Sichuan, one of the country's poorest provinces. Pray that God gives Christians in the affected areas a sense of his strength and that they will show unity in responding to this disaster.
