WORLD LEADERS GATHER IN ROME TO DISCUSS THE GROWING CRISES IN GLOBAL FOOD PRICES: The cost of basic staples has gone up by more than 80 per cent in the past three years, according to the World Bank. For those living in developing countries, where food represents 60 - 80 per cent of consumer spending, this is proving to be a massive deal; one that is pushing many to breaking point. There have already been riots in Haiti, Egypt and 35 other countries this year. Tearfund is concerned about the impact of rising food prices on poor people who struggle to cope with even small increases. Please pray for wisdom for world leaders, and that they will address the food crisis effectively. Pray that governments provide more funds to help poor countries respond to food shortages. Pray that trade agreements do not impose further inappropriate liberalisation on poor countries.
