Tearfund is urging Christians to unite in prayer for peace in Gaza. Nearly two weeks of clashes between Israel and Hamas has resulted in hundreds of deaths, mainly among Palestinians. Diplomatic efforts to broker a ceasefire are continuing with increasing international calls for the opposing sides to negotiate. Tearfund does not work in Gaza but is supporting the prayers for peace of Christian partners in neighbouring Jordan, Egypt and Lebanon. Please pray for peace and a swift end to the escalation in violence. Pray that voices urging restraint and calm will be heard on both sides. Pray that more humanitarian aid can get through to people in need.
