Tearfund report on a violent start to the New Year on the border between Uganda and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). Many people have recently been killed by a Ugandan rebel group, the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA). The LRA has been involved in a long running civil conflict but since being driven from Uganda, its attacks have moved over the border into the DRC and neighbouring Sudan. Pray for the restarting of previously failed peace talks and for the safety of those living in areas enduring raids. Pray too that the armies pursuing the LRA will show wisdom and restraint as it is reported that many of the LRA 'fighters' were themselves abducted and forced to join.
