NEWS FROM NEPAL FROM THE 'UNITED MISSION TO NEPAL' VIA TEARFUND: Nepal has a plethora of prayer needs which need bringing before the Lord. One of the biggest issues is the uncertainty that continues to dog the country's political process. The Maoists, brought into the mainstream after a civil war, remain at loggerheads with the government after disagreement earlier this year over the sacking of an army commander. Such problems underline the great need for God's intervention in the Himalayan country. The UNM & Tearfund encourages the global church community to join them in intercession for Nepal's needs, in the areas of religious conflict, disease, a looming food crisis, and the feeling of hopelessness and despair.
