A crackdown on churches in Rangoon, the former capital of Burma, is taking place with local authorities in the city ordering at least 100 churches to stop holding worship services, particularly those who meet in private property (homes). Reports say that the order could affect as many as 80 per cent of churches in the city, including several church premises which have now been locked and sealed.

Pray for all Christians in Rangoon, that they would be strengthened in their faith through this challenging period, that leaders of churches being asked to close down would be given wisdom and courage in their conversations with the authorities and in leading their congregations, that the Church in the region would continue to be a witness to others.
