... More than 1,700 vulnerable families in remote rural areas outside Haiti's capital are receiving Tearfund help after the earthquake. With heavy rains due across the Caribbean nation, tarpaulins, groundsheets and jerry cans have been distributed to areas which have received little help to date. Tearfund's relief effort, supported by the UN (which has provided helicopters to get aid to inaccessible areas) is covering both the coastal lowlands and remote highland communities. The churches in Haiti are at the forefront of relief in this earthquake zone, please pray for strength, wisdom and the compassion of Christ.
