... The local church in Egypt is increasingly facing discrimination and hostility. Christians have been subjected to violent attacks over recent weeks and months, across the country. Eleven Christian homes were set alight and 20 cars destroyed. Police arrested 30 Christians and accused them of carrying out the attacks. Please pray for people who are recovering from attacks and ask that God will bring healing to their lives. Pray for the Egyptian authorities and Muslim leaders to show tolerance towards Christians and for an end to persecution. Report:Tearfund.
