... Our prayers are needed for the central African state of Burundi where tensions are high following a controversial presidential election. There was a low turnout for the poll which saw just one candidate standing - President Pierre Nkurunziza. Emmanuel Murangira, Tearfund Country Representative for Burundi, described the situation as fragile and urged people to pray for the country. The election is the first since the end of the civil war in 2003 which claimed the lives of 300,000 people. Pray for the safety of TF staff and partners working in Burundi to bring material and spiritual transformation to it's eight million people, and for the church in Burundi to stand firm and oppose the resumption of violence.
