Lincoln 10k 2010 - Race Route, Sunday 21st March Start on Riseholme Road, (near Texaco Garage), Left at roundabout on to Longdales Road, Right on to Nettleham Road, Right on to Church Lane, Right on to Newport, Left on to Yarborough Crescent, Right on to Burton Road, Right on to Queen Elizabeth Road, Right on to Riseholme Road, Left on to Longdales Road, Right onto Nettleham Road, Straight on to Priory Gate, Right in to Minster Yard, through Exchequer Gate, Through Castle Square into Castle grounds.
