... Pastor among Uganda bombing fatalities [report from Tearfund] Dozens of Ugandan families are in mourning after more than 70 people died in terrorist attacks in the country's capital, Kampala. Bombers targeted two venues where football fans were watching the World Cup final on TV. The blasts left another 70 people injured. As Ugandan security forces begin to investigate the bombings, the work of TF partners continues unaffected, although we know that one pastor from the Pentecostal Assemblies of God church was killed. Please ask the Lord to bring his comfort to families mourning the loss of loved ones. Pray too for the work of TF and its local church partners as they strive to lift people out of physical and spiritual poverty.
