

NEW BUS BRINGS GOOD NEWS LINCOLN'S STREETS

The new Godpod bus (GODPOD2) was commissioned at a service on Saturday 14 March in Addison Drive in the St Giles area of Lincoln. In his prayer of dedication, Rev Alan Swann asked God to ensure that GODPOD2 is a safe, secure and sacred space where everyone is welcome to come on board and learn about the Christian faith.

GODPOD2 replaces the ageing GODPOD which had to be taken out of service in November 2012. Peter Good, co-ordinator of the GODPOD Team, said:

"Over the past few months we have been working hard to get GODPOD2 ready for service. We have furnished the interior with caprets and sofas and fitted a heating system. GODPOD2 is now ready to go out to schools and on the streets of Lincoln and the surrounding area. At the same time we will complete work on the bus. This includes extra lighting, electronics, power generation, a drinks machine, a storage facility and applying a decorative finish to the outside of the bus."

GODPOD2 will be in service at these places.
